Background information on the signature of the contract between F4E and the Dalkia-Veolia consortium

What is the scope of the contract?

Fusion for Energy has signed a contract for the infrastructure supply, operation, maintenance and waste management of the ITER PF coils building.

What is the duration of the contract?

The planned duration of the contract is for at least five years.

What is the value of the contract?

The overall value of the contract is in the range of 12 million EUR.

To whom is the contract awarded?

The contract is awarded to Dalkia, part of the EDF Group, together with Veolia, through its subsidiaries Veolia Propreté Industries Services (VPIS) and the Water activity of Veolia in France.
